2017 Central Valley Flood Protection Plan Update Review and Adoption Planning Progress

**BRIEFING SUMMARY**

**Board Staff Activities**

The 2017 Central Valley Flood Protection Plan (CVFPP) Update and Supplemental Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR) public comment period ended on March 31, 2017. Department of Water Resources received over 400 comments from Federal and State agencies, environmental non-governmental organizations, agricultural groups, several local and regional flood planning and water interests groups, and the general public.

The Board's first workshop was held on April 7th, and five additional workshops will be held. The intent of the workshops is to provide Board members an opportunity to discuss the 2017 CVFPP Update, associated documents, public comments, and any potential revisions to the 2017 CVFPP Update. The workshop schedule has been approved by the Board Executive Committee, is available on the Board's website and will be presented at the April 28th Board meeting.

Board staff continues to meet regularly to discuss issues, schedule and milestones, as well as stakeholder and public outreach through adoption of the 2017 CVFPP Update in June 2017. The overall schedule presented will be updated as needed.
