2017 Central Valley Flood Protection Plan Update Review and Adoption Planning Progress

BRIEFING SUMMARY

Board Staff Activities

The 2017 Central Valley Flood Protection Plan (CVFPP) Update was released for public review on December 30, 2017. In addition, the Sacramento Bee published a Notice of Availability for the Draft Supplemental Program Environmental Impact Report (EIR), commencing the public review period that will extend through March 31, 2017. Board staff coordinated with DWR Public Affairs Office on a joint Press Release announcing the publication of both the Draft 2017 CVFPP Update and Draft Supplemental Program EIR. Staff continues to coordinate regularly with DWR on the 2017 CVFPP Update and the Draft Supplemental Program EIR.

Board staff has developed a webpage dedicated to the 2017 CVFPP Update, the Supplemental Program EIR, the 2012 CVFPP, and all supporting documents and appendices. The Board voted on and approved the Public Hearing schedule at the December 16, 2016 Board Meeting. This schedule is available on the Board's 2017 CVFPP Update website. Board staff coordinates regularly on the Public Hearing process and comment response effort. In addition, Board staff continues to meet regularly to discuss issues, schedule and milestones, as well as stakeholder and public outreach through adoption of the 2017 CVFPP Update in June 2017. The overall schedule presented will be updated as needed.
