Permit No. 12796-A was issued to Darrell A. Ferreira to reinstate Application No. 12796 for the purpose of landscaping with iceplants, installing a sprinkler system, and replacing a stairway on the landward slope of the left bank levee of the Sacramento River in the Pocket Area. The landscaping and sprinkler system have been removed since the issuance of Permit 12796-A. This permit only authorizes the remaining landside stairway.	Maintenance Area 9	This action does not have the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment and thus is not a "project" for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Res.Code § 21065; Guidelines § 15378(a)).
