Stanislaus	Tuolumne River	To improve 17 acres within the Gateway Parcel of Tuolumne River Regional Park in Modesto including construction of a riverwalk trail system, a drainage swale, an outdoor classroom, a promenade boardwalk and overlook, picnic areas and native riparian restoration areas.	Designated Floodway - Tuolumne River	The Board, as a Responsible Agency under CEQA, has reviewed the Initial Study, Negative Declaration (IS/ND) (SCH No. 2005062005, June, 2005) for the Tuolumne River Regional Park Gateway Precise Plan, prepared by the lead agency, City of Modesto. These documents are available for review at the Board and City of Modesto offices. The City of Modesto determined that the project would not have a significant effect on the environment and filed a notice of determination with the State Clearinghouse on September 20, 2005. Board staff finds the proposed project will not have a potentially significant effect on the environment and there will not be a significant effect in this case because revisions in the project have been made by or agreed to by the project proponent.

9530-1	Butte Creek Farms	The project is located along Butte Slough Road, approximately 0.16 miles east of from the intersection of River Road and Butte Slough Road, in Colusa.	Colusa	Sacramento River	This is a "name change" permit only and includes conditions that are consistent with current flood control standards and policies of the Central Valley Flood Protection Board. Automatic Board Order No.9530 was issued to Mr. W. H. Halsey on March 8th, 1974 for several existing features that were deemed to be conforming with Title 23 at that time. This permit covers the authorized 16-inch steel pipe, concrete encased through levee, two concrete cutoff walls, slide gate in CM riser on waterward slope, pump on riverbank, switch panel on waterward berm, landward end of pipe crosses through 4 foot by 4 foot concrete culvert under the county road at Levee Mile 5.01; cross fence and cyclone gate, property line at Levee Mile 5.01; 30-inch CMP through levee and slide gate in CMP riser on waterward slope at Levee Mile 6.37; ramp on both slopes at Levee Mile 6.37; pump and well at landward toe at Levee Mile 6.40; numerous buildings at the landward toe at Levee Mile 6.45 to 6.48; barn at landward toe at Levee Mile 6.50; ramp on both slopes at Levee Mile 6.51; wood panel gate at Levee Mile 6.52; 24-inch CMP through levee and slide gate in CMP riser on water-ward slope at Levee Mile 6.61; ramp on landward slope at Levee Mile 6.61.
