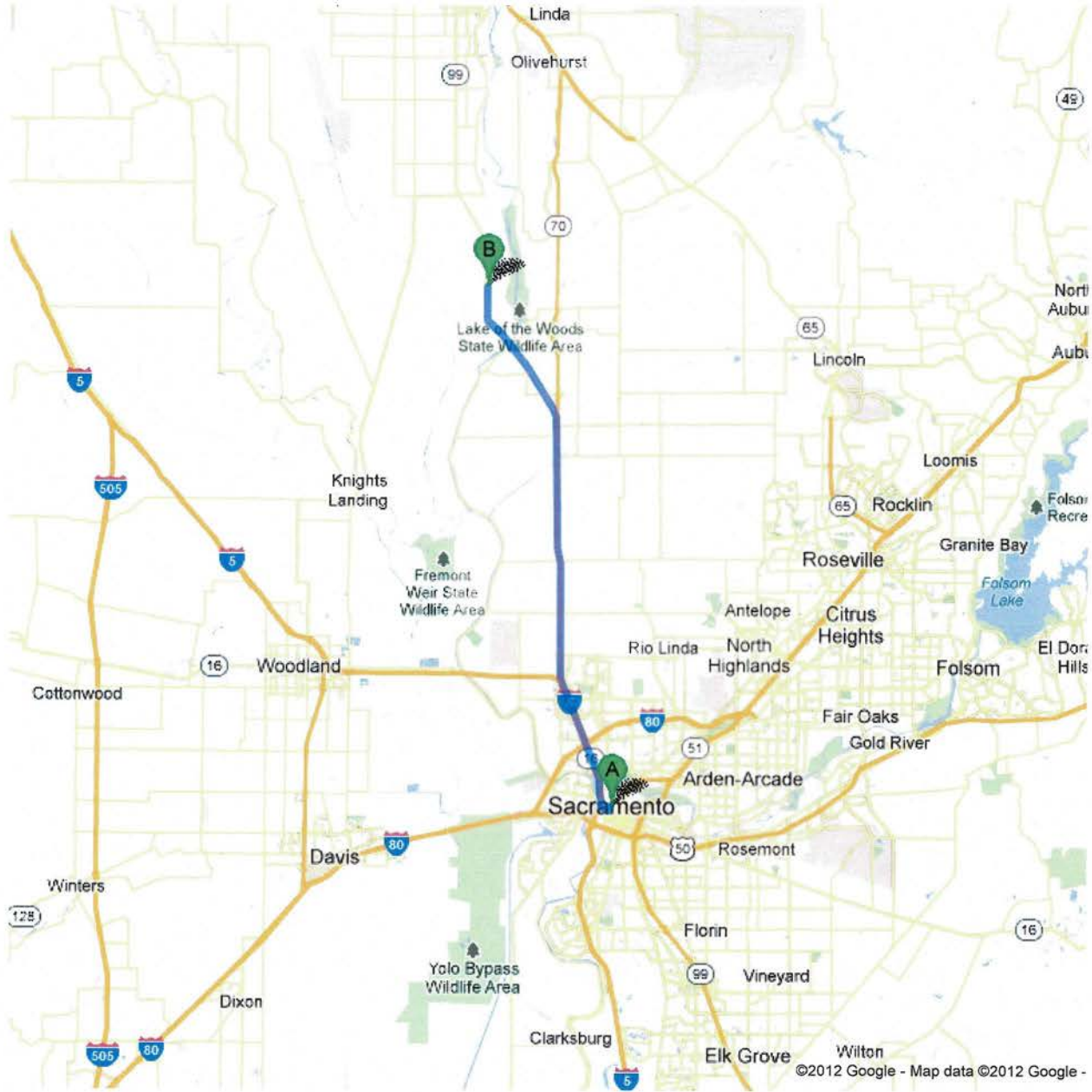

A Sacramento, CA

1. Head **south** on **9th St** toward **J St**
About 48 secs
go 0.2 mi
total 0.2 mi
2. Turn right onto **L St**
About 1 min
go 0.5 mi
total 0.7 mi
3. Turn right to merge onto **I-5 N toward Woodland**
About 7 mins
go 6.2 mi
total 6.9 mi
4. Slight **right onto CA-99 N** (signs for **Yuba City/ Marysville**)
Destination will be on the left
About 20 mins
go 20.2 mi
total 27.1 mi
