## Meeting of the Central Valley Flood Protection Board May 24, 2012 Report to the Board From Board Member Clyde Macdonald Agenda Item No. 8A - SB 753 (Steinberg)

The Senate Appropriations Committee will have its hearing on bills on the Suspense Calendar at 9:30 AM on Thursday, May 23, the day before our board hearing.

If the committee approves the bill, my expectation is that the bill would be approved "as amended." The amendments should make the language of the bill consistent with the language approved by the board, with some changes that we have discussed previously plus some minor technical changes to respond to questions raised by legislative staff, including Legislative Counsel.

According to the Appropriations Committee, the bill will be "in print" the following week, probably Tuesday the 28<sup>th</sup> or Wednesday the 29<sup>th</sup>.

The Senate would take up the bill that same week, as the deadline for bills to pass to the Assembly is Friday, May 31 – if the bill is to take effect on January 1, 2014.

Tim Washburn of the Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency made the following two suggestions:

- (1) In the Enforcement Order section, "removal <u>and</u> restoration" should be changed to "removal <u>or</u> restoration" in several places. In law, "A and B" means both A and B must occur. In law, "A or B" means either A or B, or both may occur.
- (2) In the section that allows the board to remove or modify a previously permitted encroachment, an additional subsection would be added that would require that if the board orders the removal or modification of the permitted encroachment, the board would be required to either revoke or amend the underlying permit.

I suggest that these be amended into the bill in the Assembly. Board's Legal Counsel Nicole Rinke concurs in these changes.
