BRIEFING SUMMARY

The Coordinating Committee was formed by the Flood Board and the Department of Water Resources in September 2012, as an informal discussion forum open to stakeholders interested in flood management planning for the leveed portions of the Sacramento and San Joaquin Rivers. The committee is not a decision-making body, but rather, promotes the exchange of ideas and information while facilitating effective communication among state and local agencies and NGOs. The Coordinating Committee generally meets once per month at the City of West Sacramento. A steering committee meets once per month to set meeting agendas.

Board Member Macdonald and Kim Floyd, coordinator for the Committee, will provide an annual report on the status of the Committee's activities and discuss goals for the coming year.
