TOUR SUMMARY:

The Central Valley Flood Protection Board is planning a public site visit to the Yolo Bypass on Friday, March 14, 2014 to gain a better understanding of the numerous flood control, water conservation, habitat restoration, and conservation projects targeting the Yolo Bypass, including but not limited to the Bay Delta Conservation Plan (BDCP) and Lower Sacramento River / Delta North Regional Flood Management Plan proposals in the floodway.

Tour participants will meet at 9:00 AM at the West Sacramento IKEA store parking lot; 700 IKEA Court, West Sacramento, California 95605. 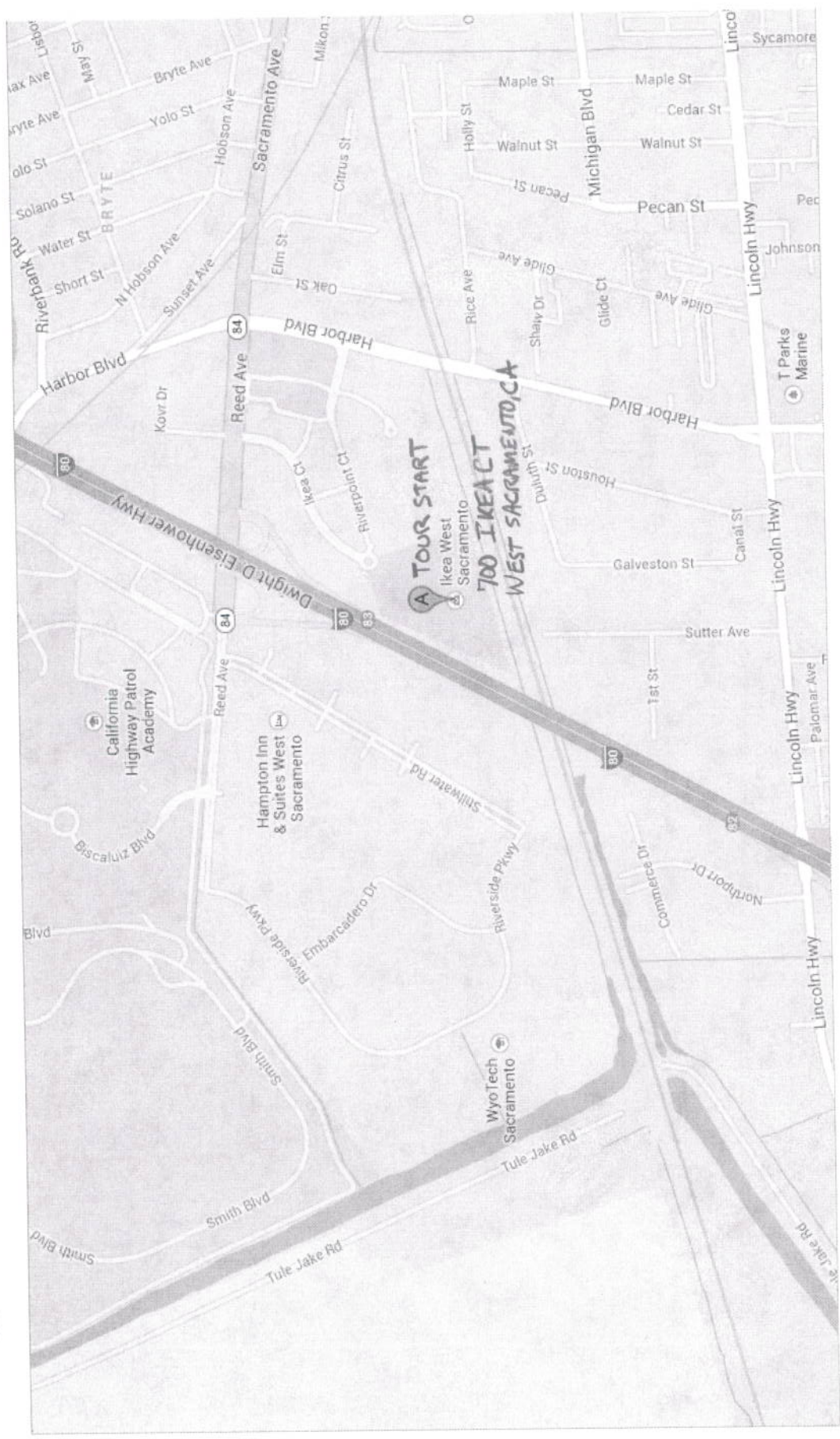

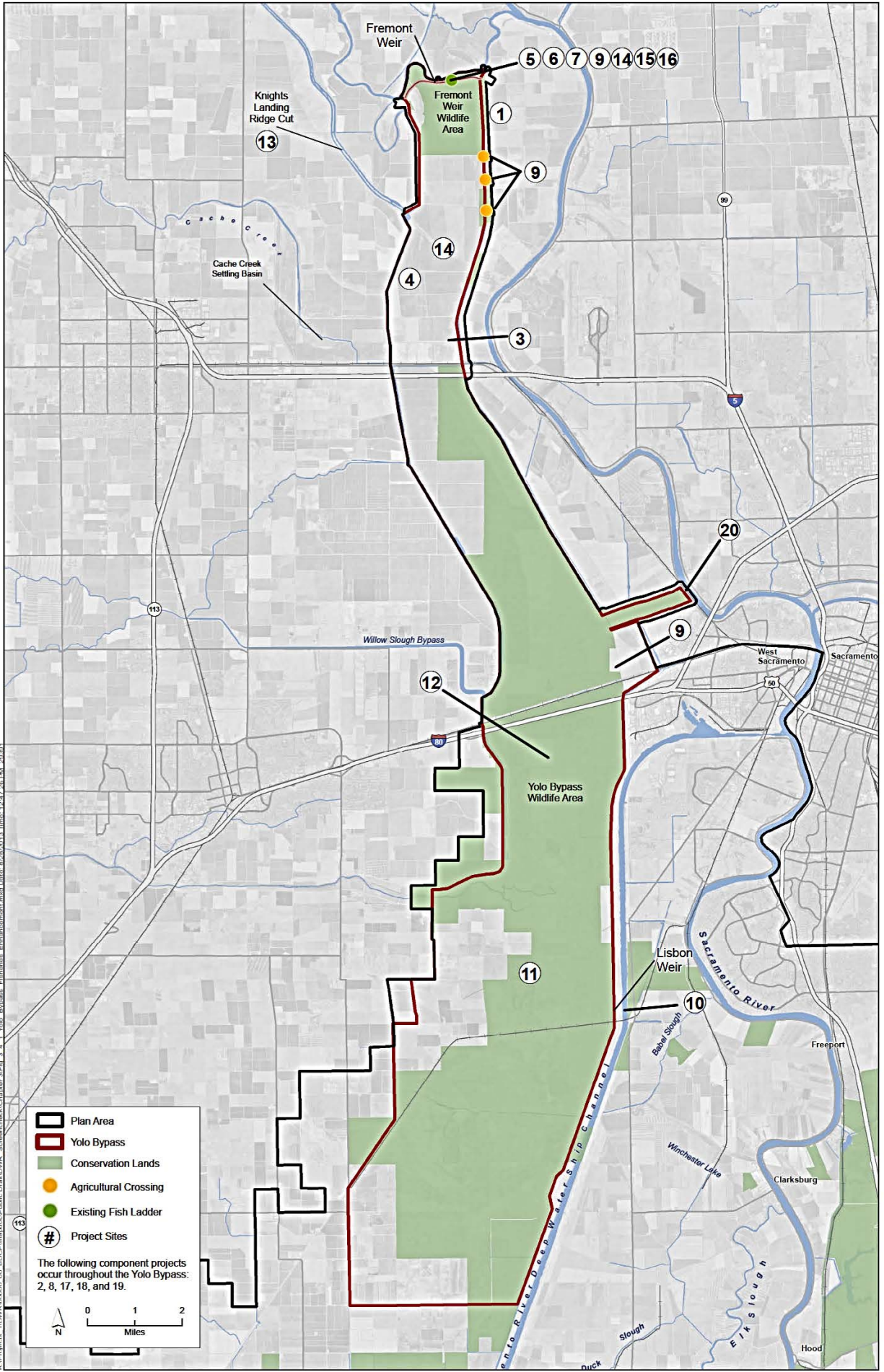
