### **TOUR SUMMARY:**

The Central Valley Flood Protection Board is planning a two-day trip to the San Joaquin area to attend a Paradise Cut Symposium in Stockton, conduct a public site visit to two seepage repair sites in RD 17 (Lathrop area), and attend an informational briefing and visits to three locations in the San Joaquin River Restoration Program. The informational briefing and site visits will allow the Board and interested parties to gain a better understanding of the flood management improvements being done in the Lathrop area, and progress on the San Joaquin River Restoration Program. Due to the distance from Sacramento and the lengthy agenda, the Board and staff will be staying overnight in Madera on September 11<sup>th</sup>.

Attendees will provide their own transportation and should bring their own water, sun protection, and wear shoes and clothing appropriate for walking outdoors on uneven ground. Maps and approximate meeting times are attached, with stops, site visits and parking areas clearly marked.

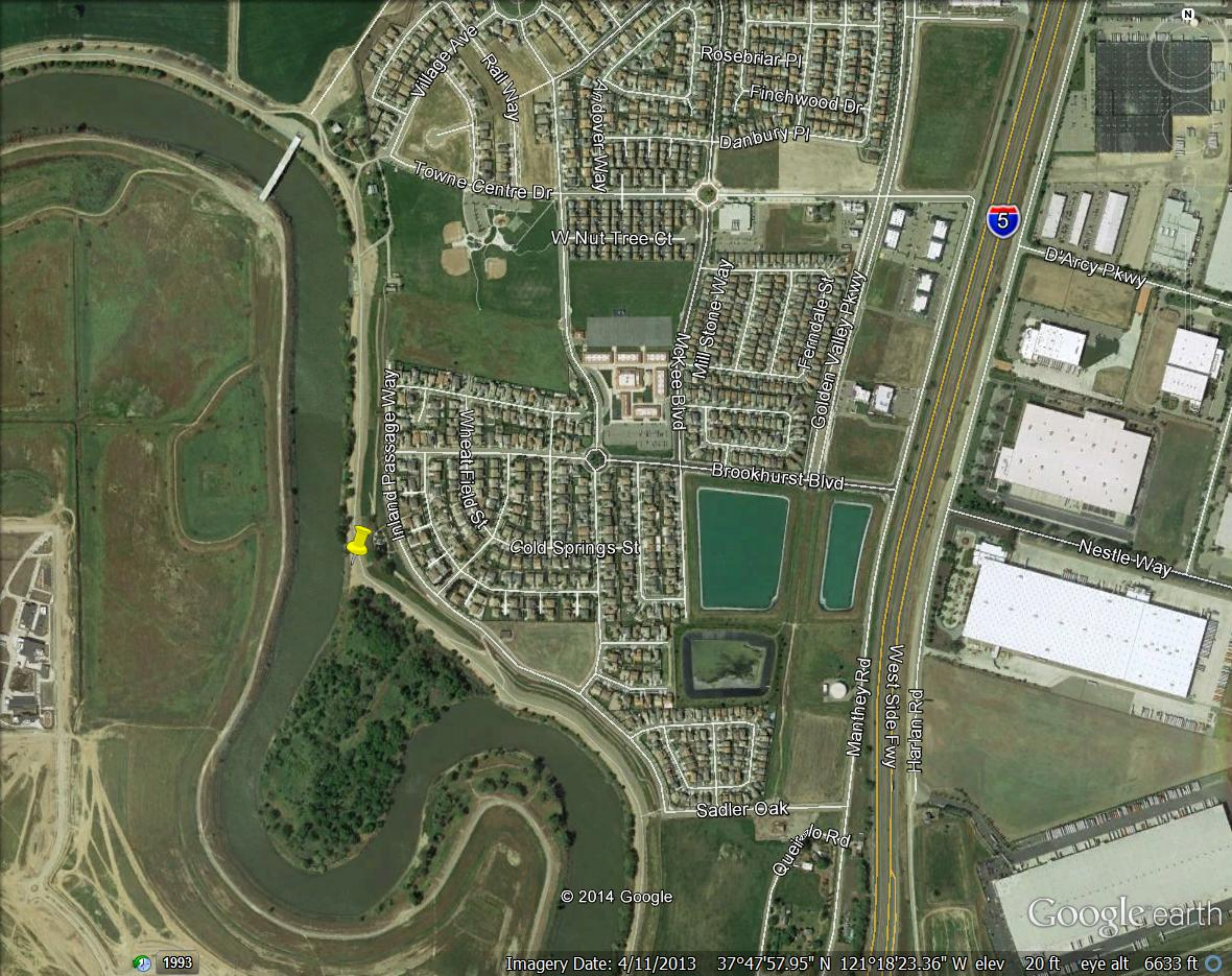
