Central Valley Flood Protection Plan Overview

BRIEFING SUMMARY

Background

The California Department of Water Resources (DWR) is preparing the 2017 Update to the Central Valley Flood Protection Plan (CVFPP). As a programmatic document, the CVFPP Update will refine the overall near-term and long-term investment needs established in the 2012 CVFPP and serve as the primary reflection of key flood management policies affecting the Central Valley relating to topics such as watershed and floodplain management, phased implementation and prioritization, long-term system management, residual risk management, and integration of multiple benefits. The CVFPP Update will also feature application of an outcome-based planning framework, consistent with other DWR programs in Integrated Water Management.

Current Status

Document development is underway, with an administrative draft scheduled for October 2016 and a public draft December 2016. DWR is seeking CVFPB adoption of the final plan update in June 2017.
