N/A	<p>The Board, as a responsible agency under CEQA, has reviewed the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) (SCH Number: 2015061097, June 2015) and Mitigation Measures for the Lower Merced River Boat Access Ramp Project prepared by Merced Irrigation District as the lead agency. These documents including project design are available for review at the Board and District offices.</p> <p>The Merced Irrigation District determined that the project would not have a significant effect on the environment and filed a Notice of Determination on August 11, 2015 with the Merced County Clerk. Staff finds that although the proposed project could have a potentially significant effect on the environment, there will not be a significant effect in this case because revisions in the project have been made by or agreed to by the project proponent. The project proponent has incorporated mandatory mitigation measures into the project plans to avoid identified impacts or to mitigate such impacts to a point where no significant impacts will occur. These mitigation measures are included in the project proponent's IS/MND and address impacts to biological resources. This permit supplements Permit Number 3489 that was issued to Kirtland Bros. on September 21, 1960, for installation of a 40 H.P. pumping plant and pipe through the left bank levee, Feather River, approximately 3/4 of a mile North of Verona, levee mile 11.35, Reclamation District No. 1001, Section 15, Township 11 North, Range 3 East, M.D.B.&M., Sutter County.
