- *Mitigation required by:*
 - 2015 USFWS Biological Opinion
 - 2015 Fish and Wildlife Coordination Act Report

Project Description

- *Approximately 24-acre riparian site*
 - Mitigates for 12 acres of tree removal
- *Begin Summer 2019*
 - Approximately 5 months to complete
- *Monitor 5 years*
- *Maintain in perpetuity*
