**Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration****Central Valley Flood Protection Board  
Sacramento County, California**

- Project Title:** American River Watershed Common Features 2016 (ARCF), Beach-Stone Lakes Mitigation Site (Project)
- Project Location:** The proposed Project is located south of Freeport, California, west of Interstate 5, east of Highway 160, and north of Morrison Creek, in Sacramento County.
- Project Description:** The Central Valley Flood Protection Board (CVFPB) along with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) and Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency (SAFCA) propose to construct a 24.2-acre riparian mitigation site. The Project would mitigate for riparian habitat expected to be lost or degraded by the construction of planned levee improvements on the Sacramento River east levee as a part of the overall ARCF 2016 Project.

Following the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), a Draft Supplemental Environmental Assessment/Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (EA/IS/MND) has been prepared for this Project. The document supplements the ARCF 2016 General Reevaluation Report Final Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report. The results of the Draft Supplemental EA/IS/MND indicate that mitigation measures would reduce all potential adverse impacts to less-than-significant levels. The CVFPB will consider adoption of the MND and approval of the Project during a regularly scheduled CVFPB meeting in late Spring or early Summer 2019:
