N/A	<p>The Board, as a responsible agency under CEQA, has reviewed the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) (SCH Number: 2016082063, August 2016) and Mitigation Measures for the Mather Dam Improvements Project prepared by Sacramento County as the lead agency. These documents including project design are available for review at the Board and County offices.</p> <p>The County of Sacramento determined that the project would not have a significant effect on the environment and filed a Notice of Determination on December 13, 2016 with the State Clearinghouse. Staff finds that although the proposed project could have a potentially significant effect on the environment, there will not be a significant effect in this case because revisions in the project have been made by or agreed to by the project proponent. The project proponent has incorporated mandatory mitigation measures into the project plans to avoid identified impacts or to mitigate such impacts to a point where no significant impacts will occur. These mitigation measures are included in the project proponent's IS/MND and address impacts to biological resources and cultural resources.
