Application Number: 11823-1

Applicant: Kurt Glassman

Location Description: The project is located about 0.3 miles from the intersection of Elkhorn Boulevard and Garden Highway, northwest of the City of Sacramento at 6687 Garden Highway.

County: Sacramento

Stream: Sacramento River

Project Description: To authorize and relocate an existing iron fence along Garden Highway. The fence will be relocated approximately 20 feet from the centerline of the Highway towards the residence. This is also a "name change" permit and includes conditions that are consistent with current flood control standards and policies of the Central Valley Flood Protection Board. This permit supplements Permit no. 11823 that was issued to Ted and Mary Hillard on January 7, 1977 "To place embankment on berm and construct a house on top, with septic tank, water well and driveways, all on the left bank of the Sacramento River, approximately 1500 feet upstream from Elkhorn Road."

LMA Endorsement: Reclamation District 1000

CEQA Finding: Board staff has determined the project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 1, Existing Facilities, and Class 3, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures categorical exemptions (CEQA Guidelines § 15301 and § 15303), because the proposed activity consists of permitting and altering the location of an existing fence, which in turn will place a "new" accessory structure on the residential property, and does not result in significant effects to the environment. In addition, an application to change the name of the permittee does not have the potential to result in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and thus, is not a "project" for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code § 21065; CEQA Guidelines § 15378(a)). Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA Guidelines § 15300.2 apply.

Application Number: 12707-1

Applicant: Casa Lupe Farms

Location Description: The pipeline is located approximately 500 feet downstream from the confluence with Butte Creek.

County: Sutter

Stream: Sacramento River

Project Description: To remove and replace approximately 116 feet of 14 inch diameter steel pipe through the left (northeast) levee of the Sacramento River. This is also a "name change" permit that includes conditions that are consistent with current flood control standards and policies of the Central Valley Flood Protection Board.

This permit supplements Permit No. 12707 that was issued to Roger C. Wilber of Butte Creek Farms on 6/1/1979 to install a 40-horsepower pump with a 14-inch diameter steel discharge pipe through the left bank levee of the Sacramento River.

LMA Endorsement: Reclamation District 70

CEQA Finding: Board staff has determined that the project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 2, Replacement or Reconstruction categorical exemption (CEQA Guidelines § 15302), because the activity consists of replacement and reconstruction of an existing structure, and the new structure will be located on the same site and will have the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced. In addition, an application to change the name of the permittee does not have the potential to result in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and thus, is not a “project” for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code § 21065; CEQA Guidelines § 15378(a)). Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA Guidelines § 15300.2 apply.

Application Number: 19538

Applicant: SBM Realty LLC

Location Description: The proposed project site is approximately 200 feet south of Elder Creek Road and 5 miles west of Florin-Perkins Road.

County: Sacramento

Stream: Morrison Creek

Project Description: To construct a new 15-inch diameter storm drain penetration into Morrison Creek to provide drainage release for frontage improvements at 8280 Elder Creek Road.

LMA Endorsement: N/A

CEQA Finding: Board staff has determined the project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 3, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures categorical exemption (CEQA Guidelines § 15303), because the proposed activity consists of the construction and location of a limited number of new, small facilities or structures (a new 15-inch diameter storm drain). Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA Guidelines § 15300.2 apply.

Application Number: 19541

Applicant: Brown Strauss Steel

Location Description: The project is located where East Mariposa Road crosses Duck Creek, approximately 1,100 feet northwest from the intersection of E Mariposa Road and Carpenter Road in the City of Stockton.

County: San Joaquin

Stream: Duck Creek

Project Description: To construct a 60-foot-wide access road across Duck Creek. The crossing will consist of three 87-inch by 63-inch arch metal culverts, headwalls, wingwalls, and rock slope protection.

LMA Endorsement: San Joaquin County Flood Control and Water Conservation District

CEQA Finding: Board staff has determined the project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 3, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures categorical exemption (CEQA Guidelines § 15303), because the proposed activity would construct an access road of reasonable length to an existing industrial facility (a 60-foot-long

access road/crossing with three, 87-inch x 63-inch arch metal culverts, headwalls, wingwalls, and rock slope protection). Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA Guidelines § 15300.2 apply.
