BOARD CEQA PROCESS



Per § 15096 CEQA Guidelines:

- Consideration of the PEIR and decision to approve a plan:
 - DWR CEQA Lead Agency
 - Board CEQA Responsible Agency
 - Draft PEIR, March 2012, State Clearinghouse No. 2010102044
 - Final PEIR, June 2012, Certification Anticipated June 28, 2012
- Mitigation measures to lessen or avoid environmental impacts
- Findings on significant impacts
- Notice of Determination

Board Resolution 2012-25



CVFPB Decision to Adopt the CVFPP includes CEQA findings:

- Environmental impacts of the CVFPP as described in the PEIR
- Board reached its own conclusions by considering the CVFPP and the PEIR prepared by the lead agency – DWR
- Adoption of DWR mitigation measures and findings of significant impacts
- Notice of Determination - Directs the Executive Officer to file with the State Clearinghouse
