SERP Goal

- **BENEFIT: PUBLIC SAFETY and ENVIRONMENT**
 - Reduce Number of Large Scale Repairs
 - Prevent Escalating Loss of Existing Vegetation

- Five year “pilot”
- Fifteen erosion repairs per year
- DWR-maintained levees



DWR SMALL EROSION REPAIR PROGRAM 2014 SITE LOCATIONS


