**OVERVIEW OF RESOLVED ENCROACHMENT VIOLATIONS DURING THE 2014  
AND 2015 CALENDAR YEARS**

**BRIEFING SUMMARY**

**Background**

The enforcement staff pursues violations using an enforcement program that increases the level of enforcement until compliance is reached. This approach is a means to reach compliance at the lowest possible level of enforcement which is less exhaustive on resources for both the State and the respondent. The enforcement tools that are available are the pre-enforcement Fact Finding Letter (FFL), the Notice of Violation (NOV), and Cease and Desist Order (C&D).

Violations can be resolved by the local maintaining agencies or by the responsible parties. Depending on the severity of the violation, staff will notify the local maintaining agency and the responsible party either with pre-enforcement methods such as a phone call or a fact finding letter, or through the enforcement process starting with a notice of violation.

Staff will present the enforcement activities that have resulted in resolved violations during the 2014 and 2015 calendar years.
