4. AMERICAN RIVER COMMON FEATURES 2016 PROJECT UPDATES

A. Workshop Introduction

Staff will introduce the workshop, including agenda topics, presenters, and goals of the workshop.

B. American River Common Features 2016 Project Update

USACE staff will provide a high-level overview of the American River Common Features 2016 Project. The presentation will provide updates on the on-going and upcoming construction, major milestones, and project schedule.

C. Sacramento Weir Widening Project

The presenters will give an overview of the proposed Sacramento Weir Widening project and associated details. The presentation will cover details of the Weir Widening project along with the fish passage structure, weir operation, project schedule, and construction milestones.

D. Encroachment Removal Incentive Program (ERIP)

Board Staff will give a brief overview of the Encroachment Removal Incentive Program initiated by the Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency. The overview will cover the purpose of the Program, the Program's success to date, and anticipated activities for upcoming work.

E. Sacramento River East Levee Project Seepage and Stability

Board staff will give an overview of each contract for the Seepage and Stability levee improvements and the impacted encroachments within the Sacramento River East Levee Project. The presentation will cover completed work in 2020, current on-going work in 2021, and future work planned for 2022 and 2023. Staff will also provide survey results of existing levee access points in Maintenance Area 9.

F. Erosion Repair

Board Staff will provide an update on the proposed erosion work regarding contract phases and construction schedule along the Sacramento and American Rivers. Updates for each contract will cover the contract limits, design status, scheduled construction, and the impacted encroachments.
