INFORMATIONAL BRIEFING

Sacramento and San Joaquin Drainage District Assessment District Feasibility Study

BRIEFING SUMMARY

Background

A contract for the Central Valley Flood Protection Board's (Board) Sacramento and San Joaquin Drainage District (SSJDD) Assessment District Feasibility Study was issued on December 20, 2019. The consultant team is responsible for evaluating the feasibility of reutilizing the SSJDD Assessment to provide funding for system-wide improvements and the operation and maintenance of associated flood control structures and levees within the State Plan of Flood Control. The project will culminate with a Report of Findings for consideration by the Board.

Current Status

The consultant team has held a series of stakeholder engagement meetings to identify the services/activities to be included in the SSJDD Assessment District Feasibility Study. Five potential service areas have been identified. The consultant team has performed the beneficiary analysis for one of the service areas for potentially assessing all properties benefiting from O&M of regional facilities. The preliminary results have been reviewed with stakeholders and the consultant team is addressing stakeholder concerns in order to finalize the analysis.

Board staff, Ruth Darling, will introduce the consultant team to provide an Informational Briefing to the Board on the team's approach and findings in anticipation of a more detailed discussion at the Board Workshop on July 10, 2021.
