A. <u>Permit No. 4902-1 Lawrence Bass</u> (Deb Biswas, Operations Branch, Board Staff)

Consider approval of Permit No. 4902-1 to repair approximately 90 feet of damaged bank protection along the right (north) bank of the American River and to authorize an existing retaining wall, concrete boat ramp, stairway, and handrail down to the slope of the bank. The project site is located on the waterside of the Units 9 and 10, American River right (north) bank levee at 1622 McClaren Drive in Carmichael. (Sacramento County)

B. <u>Permit No. 18956-5, High Speed Rail Authority</u> (Ali Porbaha, Plan Implementation and Compliance Branch, Board Staff)

Consider approval of Permit No. 18956-5 to construct a new two track precast railroad bridge track, 318 feet long and 44 feet wide, supported on two bents, with two 8-foot diameter columns at each bent and abutments with 5-foot diameter Cast-In-Drilled Hole concrete pile foundations for the High-Speed Train. The proposed bridge will cross the Cole Slough which is about 0.3 miles upstream of intersection of Cole Slough and Highway 43 in Laton. (Fresno County)

C. <u>Permit No. 19570 Department of Water Resources (DWR)</u> (*Justin Logan, Operations Branch, Board Staff*)

Consider approval of Permit No. 19570 to breach the perimeter non-federal levee along the left (south) bank of the Consumes River to restore tidal and fluvial flows as part of the Grizzly Slough Floodplain Restoration Project. The proposed project is located at the confluence of Grizzly Slough and the Cosumnes River Designated Floodway, north of New Hope Road. (Sacramento County)

D. <u>Permit No. 19531 Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) Bridge Replacement</u> (*Humberto Negrete, Operations Branch, Board Staff*)

Consider approval of Permit No. 19531 to replace the existing single-track, 3-span, 180foot long, deck plate girder open deck bridge on steel cylinder piers and stone abutments with a single-track, 4-span, 252-foot long bridge. The project is located where the existing UPRR Valley Subdivision rail line spans Deer Creek, approximately 2.5-miles upstream of the confluence with the Sacramento River and approximately 0.5-miles north of the community of Vina.
