Approve permit 19606 to construct a new 60-foot by 80-foot steel and timber framed private barn on a gravel pad. The project is located at 881 County Road Y, approximately 2 miles south of the community of Butte City, within Area E of the Butte Basin. (Glenn County)

B. <u>Initial Statement of No Objection, Department of Water Resources, Butte Slough Outfall Gates Repair Project</u> (*Dustin Sanoski, Flood System Improvement Branch, Board Staff*)

Approve the initial Statement of No Objection to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) pursuant to 33 USC 408 (Section 408), requesting that the USACE evaluate the Section 408 request to alter levees of the Sacramento River Flood Control Project (SRFCP) in the vicinity of the town of Colusa, Colusa County. Department of Water Resources proposes to repair the existing and deteriorating Butte Slough Outfall Gates to maintain function on the left bank of the Sacramento River within Unit 161 of the SRFCP, approximately twenty miles southeast of the town of Colusa.

C. <u>Permit 3520-1 Hills Ferry Road Bridge Replacement</u> (*Humberto Negrete, Operations Branch, Board Staff*)

Approve permit 3520-1 to remove and replace the existing Hills Ferry Road Bridge across the San Joaquin River with an approximately 760-foot long, 39.5-foot wide, 5-span cast-in-place reinforced concrete slab bridge with Six (6) cast in drilled hole piles. Improvements include

realigning the east and west approach roads; installing a storm drain manhole with an 18-inch diameter HDPE pipe and rock slope protection (RSP) outfall; installing fencing and a 6-foot-wide gate; and placing RSP around both abutments. Temporary falsework will also be installed and will remain in the channel during flood season. The project is located approximately 400 feet upstream of the confluence of the San Joaquin and Merced Rivers, east of the town of Hills Ferry. (Stanislaus County)
