Location Description: The project is located in Sacramento, west of Riverside Boulevard at 949 Piedmont Drive. (Section 22, T8N, R4E, MDB&M, Maintenance Area 9, Sacramento River, Sacramento County).

County: Sacramento

Stream: Sacramento River

Project Description: This is a “name change” permit and supersedes the previously issued name change Permit No. 14205-1 EO, authorizing an existing floating boat dock anchored by existing three pilings and includes conditions that are consistent with current flood control standards and policies of the Central Valley Flood Protection Board. This permit supersedes Permit No. 14205 GM that was issued to Mr. William Peron on September 8, 1987, for a floating boat dock anchored by three pilings on the left bank of the Sacramento River.

LMA Endorsement: Maintenance Area 9

CEQA Finding: Board staff has determined that the proposed action does not have the potential for resulting in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment and thus is not a “project” for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code § 21065; CEQA Guidelines § 15378(a))

### Application Number: 19709

Applicant: Hidenori Asano and Fumiko Asano Family Trust u/d/t dated March 30, 2006

Location Description: The irrigation facility is located at the west end of West Mathews Road, Reclamation District 17 Unit 2, San Joaquin River, in French Camp, California and about 0.2 miles north of the Howard Road Bridge

County: San Joaquin

Stream: San Joaquin River

Project Description: To authorize an existing irrigation facility which includes a waterside pumphouse, 8-inch diameter up-and-over pipe, electrical conduit, siphon breaker with protective housing on the landside hinge, landside concrete standpipe and service pole. This facility was previously authorized by Permit Number 15104 (March 29, 1989) with USACE concurrence (November 21, 1988). This facility is also identified in USACE Sacramento O&M Manual, Unit 2, May 1963 (Revised December 29, 2016) as an 8-inch pipe at LM 2.69. This is also a name change permit and includes conditions that are consistent with current flood control standards and policies of the Central Valley Flood Protection Board.

## LMA Endorsement: Reclamation District 17

CEQA Finding: Board staff has determined that the project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 1, Existing Facilities categorical exemption (CEQA Guidelines § 15301), because the activity consists of permitting existing facilities including: a waterside pumphouse, 8-inch diameter up-and-over pipe, electrical conduit, siphon breaker with protective housing on the landside hinge, landside concrete standpipe and service pole. No expansion of existing or former use will occur. Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA Guidelines § 15300.2 apply. Board staff has also determined that an application to change the name of the permittee does not have the potential to result in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and thus, is not a “project” for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code § 21065; CEQA Guidelines § 15378(a)).
