Notice is hereby given that at the above-referenced date, time and location, the Central Valley Flood Protection Board will consider adopting a resolution to establish the boundaries of Maintenance Area 20 benefited by the continued maintenance of Levee Units 3b, 5 and 6 maintained by Reclamation District 784, and Levee Unit 6 maintained by Reclamation District 817. The public may view a map showing the proposed boundaries at the Central Valley Flood Protection Board located at 3310 El Camino Ave, Suite 170, Sacramento, CA 95821 or online at <https://cvfpb.ca.gov/public-notices/>.

Proposed Maintenance Area 20 is in Yuba County, approximately 14 miles southeast of Yuba City and seven miles west of the City of Wheatland. It includes lands bounded to the north by Best Slough, to the west by the Western Pacific Intercepting Canal, to the south by the Bear River, and to the east by high ground near Forty Mile Road.
